GENERAL TICKETING INFORMATION

Warrington RUFC : Ticketing for Twickenham – Home and Autumn Internationals and exhibition matches

Warrington RUFC have privileged access to tickets for all matches played at Twickenham stadium – the home if English Rugby – including the Home and Autumn Internationals, the Aviva Premiership double header, Barbarians games and the NFL American Football matches that currently take place every Autumn. We also get access to England's away fixtures in the 6 Nations. Tickets are released to the clubs before they go on sale to the general public (if at all!) and while availability for the most popular matches is limited we have unlimited access to some matches.

Ticket prices vary depending on the match but are typically between £140 and £45 for the internationals and between £45 to £20 for the premiership. These prices at a discount to the standard price charged when the tickets are on general sale. Some matches also offer child tickets at a reduced price.

Ticketing process

Ticket availability will be mailed to all members who have registered and will be posted on our Pitchero page and on the notice board in the sports club. If you would like to receive these updates please register by sending an e-mail with the subject 'Sign Me Up' to tickets@warringtonrufc.co.uk. Please give your name, address and a contact number in the body of the mail.

Anyone interested in applying for tickets must mail the ticketing officer before the application cutoff date. Please wait until you have been informed of availability before applying and don't apply in anticipation of tickets being released – this won't increase your chances of getting tickets for the popular matches. Note that although you can apply for as many tickets for as many matches as you want there is no guarantee that your application will be successful.

The RFU are providing a ticket re-sale service where spare or unwanted tickets can be sold. Anyone whose initial ticket application is unsuccessful will be able to apply again during the very limited resale window but note that these tickets will only be available at the higher standard price and availability is likely to be even more limited.

Successful applicants who no longer need their tickets MUST inform the club's ticketing officer who will either offer them to an un-successful applicant or offer them for sale to other clubs during the re-sale window. A refund will only be made if the tickets are successfully sold. Booking fees will not be refunded. Any tickets that are available for general sale will be on sale through the RFU ticketing site and Ticketmaster.

Where demand for tickets exceeds availability the club will allocate the tickets using a fair and proportional method. All successful applicants will receive at least 2 tickets. The rationing process will not be influenced by offers of money, club status, size of applicant or any other inducements so please don't try, however subtly.

Please note that only fully paid up club members (playing or social) can apply for tickets

Terms and Conditions

There will be booking fee of £5 per ticket charged on top of the ticket price.

Payment must be made in full by bank transfer within 5 days of receiving notification of a successful application.

In the event that you no longer want the tickets you must inform the ticketing office immediately. If possible the tickets will then be offered to another club member or posted for re-sale on the official RFU re-sale site. You will receive a refund for the original price paid only if the tickets are successfully re-sold. Booking fees are non-refundable. Note that each re-sale option is only available for a limited time and it may not be possible to re-sell tickets if this window is missed.

Any member who is found to have traded or to have attempted to trade tickets allocated to them by the club themselves will be banned in perpetuity from applying for further club ticket allocations.
