A new sanction table for the adult game will be applied this season and strengthens sanctions where foul play includes contact with a player's head.

World Rugby consulted with Unions last year before issuing new, simplified Laws of the Game and revised sanction tables. The RFU and other Unions subsequently submitted further feedback ahead of a meeting in Dublin last March and now a number of additional changes have been made to the sanction table, the most significant being:

Any act of foul play which results in contact with the head shall result in at least a mid-range sanction

The remainder of the table includes:

	Punching and Striking with hand or arm have now been combined under the same entry points
	The entry points for punching/striking have increased
	Mid-range entry is now 6 weeks (formerly 4)
	Top end entry is now 10+ weeks (formerly 8+)
	The low end entry point for striking with the head has increased from 4 to 6 weeks
9.27 A player must not disrespect the authority of a Match Official.	This is a new category and the following entry points apply:- Low: 2 weeks Mid: 4 weeks Top: 6+ weeks
A player must not verbally abuse a Match Official. Verbal abuse includes, but is not limited to, abuse based on: religion, colour, national or ethnic origin, sexual orientation.	This is a new category and the following entry points apply:- Low: 6 weeks Mid: 12 weeks Top: 18+ weeks
A player must not make physical contact with Match Officials.	This is a new category and the following entry points apply:- Low: 6 weeks Mid: 12 weeks Top: 18+ weeks
